

Kee Kee Buckley RTFF Co-Founder

Kee Kee Buckley is a writer, producer and director of independent films and documentaries. She is a founding partner of Ad Hoc Media Partners, a production company that has several music and travel docuseries and narrative feature films in various stages of production. She is currently producing and directing a TV series called Road Trip America that will air on Discovery in early 2019.

Previously, for over 13 years, Kee Kee was a senior executive with Lakeshore Entertainment, one of Hollywood's leading independent production, finance and international sales and distribution companies. As Senior Vice President of Music and Business Affairs, Kee Kee managed various business affairs operations for the company, which included involvement in the production of over 50 motion pictures during her tenure. Among them were the Academy Award-winning Million Dollar Baby and the blockbuster Underworld franchise.

Outside of her entertainment industry endeavors, Kee Kee owns the popular blog about innerpeace, Seeking Shama; is an inventor and patent holder for the critically acclaimed Shama
Yoga Rug; she has served as the vice chair of APECA, a nonprofit dedicated to preserving the
Peruvian Amazon rainforest; and has served on the Midwest Advisory Board of Best Buddies,
an organization that enhances the lives of individuals with intellectual disabilities. A member of
the Illinois State Bar, Kee Kee received a J.D. from Chicago-Kent College of Law and a B.A.
from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in Journalism and Advertising.



MAP of SREENINGS








Lauren Hirsch-Williams - Global Distributor/Executive Producer

Lauren is voting BAFTA member, award-winning writer, global distributor/syndicator, producer of both film and television and Founder of MovieHatch, one of the first crowd-sourcing sites in the entertainment industry. She joined forces with a global distribution and syndication company to combine all efforts in a business called Global Media Fusion. The team works with dozens of television networks around the world, including all the Discovery channels, Channel 4, NBC, ABC, A&E, AXS, NTD/Epoch Media and many others. These networks cover over 2 billion households in a broadcast capacity and over 5 Billion digital views per month online.

She is a former Worldwide Director of Advertising and Consumer Communications at PepsiCo accountable for overseeing brand and corporate advertising on Frito-Lay's 15+ brands, including Doritos, Tostitos, Lays, Ruffles and Cheetos in over 40 countries. At Pepsi, Lauren was part of the team that pioneered product placement in the entertainment industry beginning with high profile, Oscar-nominated films such as RAIN MAN, featuring Cheetos, and BACK TO THE FUTURE.

Lynne Litt - TV Writer of Lost, Law & Order, NCIS New Orleans

After years as a lawyer in both NYC and Los Angeles, Lynne combined her passion for the law with her other true love: writing: She is a published poet, a first time novelist and has been a television drama writer for the past fifteen years. Though Lynne has stretched her TV writing wings into a variety of genres, she soars highest, and happiest, when writing about rich characters in the legal and criminal world.



In her spare time over the course of the years, Lynne wrote her very first novel. A true labor of love for her, the novel is centered on a young female New York City prosecutor who becomes embroiled in a major corruption scandal in the DAs office and at the highest levels of the NYPD.





Virginia Longmuir - EVP of RatPac Entertainment

Virginia is an Australian-American attorney specializing in Entertainment law who is admitted to practice law in California and Australia. Virginia got her BA and LLB from the University of New South Wales, Sydney and practiced M&A transactions and gaming law while in Australia. She immigrated to the United States in 1995 and has been working in Entertainment Law for the past 18 years as EVP, Business & Legal Affairs at Lakeshore Entertainment Group, EVP, Business & Legal Affairs at Paramount Vantage, General Counsel at Sierra/Affinity LLC and most recently, EVP, Business & Legal Affairs at RATPAC Entertainment and it's affiliated companies.



### **Hunt Lowry - CEO / President of Roserock Films**

Hunt is the CEO/ President of Roserock Films located on the Warner Bros. lot. He is a producer of over 30 films and facilitated a strategic partnership between Warner Bros. and Abu Dhabi for the establishment of a Warner Bros. theme park, hotel, and theaters in Abu Dhabi along with a film fund and interactive games fund with Warner Bros. The theme park is scheduled to open later this year (2018).

Lowry most recently produced the country music film Pure Country: Pure Heart for Warner Home Entertainment (2017) with Laura Bell Bundy and Willie Nelson that premiered at the Bentonville Film Festival. Prior to that, he produced Pure Country 2: The Gift (Warner Bros.), the Robert Rodriguez film Shorts (Warner Bros., as executive producer); the standup comedy series of films Thou Shalt Laugh; Dreamer: Inspired by a True Story (Dreamworks) starring Kurt Russell and Dakota Fanning; and the critically-acclaimed Duma (Warner Bros.) directed by Carroll Ballard about a boy and his pet cheetah in South Africa. Lowry is also partnered with DJ Parmar in Original Entertainment which closed a deal to remake a slate of five major Hollywood films in India as Bollywood films, the first of which, the Bollywood version of Rambo, goes into production later this year.

Hunt Lowry has had offices on the Warner Bros. lot since 2000 when he served as the CEO/ President of Gaylord Films and its specialty division, Pandora, for four years. There, he structured a long-term co-financing and production deal with Warner Bros., and under the deal, produced the box office hits A Cinderella Story starring Hilary Duff and Chad Michael Murray; What a Girl Wants starring Amanda Bynes, Colin Firth and Kelly Preston; A Walk To Remember, starring Mandy Moore and Shane West; The Divine Secrets of the Ya-Ya Sisterhood starring Ashley Judd, Ellen Burstyn and Sandra Bullock; and White Oleander starring Michelle Pfeiffer, Renee Zellweger and Robin Wright Penn. Lowry also produced The Blue Collar Comedy Tour starring Jeff Foxworthy, the sci-fi thriller Cypher starring Jeremy Northam and Lucy Liu, the teen skateboard comedy Grind, and Welcome to Collinwood with William Macy, Sam Rockwell and George Clooney.

Lowry also executive produced the critically acclaimed film Donnie Darko starring Jake Gyllenhaal, Jena Malone, Drew Barrymore, Noah Wyle and Patrick Swayze. The film premiered at the 2001 Sundance Film Festival and was nominated for the Grand Jury Prize as well as three Independent Spirit Awards.

Prior to Gaylord Films/ Pandora, Lowry had a first look producing deal at Walt Disney Pictures where he produced such films as Disney's The Kid starring Bruce Willis and Jon Turtletaub's Instinct starring Anthony Hopkins, Cuba Gooding Jr. and Donald Sutherland. He also produced Hounded for the Walt Disney Channel.

### Allan F. Nicholls - Producer, Director, Actor, Composer

Allan is a BAFTA and WGA award nominated veteran of the film industry having produced, directed, acted, and composed music for the past forty years.

He is most noted for his collaborations with Robert Altman, Tim Robbins, and John Madden. Often performing multiple roles for a film, his experiences include associate producer and assistant director on Oscar nominated Dead Man Walking (1995), assistant director on the Oscar nominated The Player (1992), executive producer and assistant director for the Palme d'Or nominated Cradle Will Rock (1999), and associate producer on the Golden Globe nominated Bob Roberts (1992). His television experience includes, amongst others, being an associate director on Saturday Night Live (1989-91) and first assistant director on both Tanner '88 (1988) and Tanner on Tanner (2004). He co-wrote A Perfect Couple (1979) and the BAFTA nominated A Wedding (1978), both directed by Robert Altman. He has also taught screenwriting at Burlington College, NYU's Tisch Asia School of The Arts (Singapore) and served as the Artistic Director of New York Film Academy-Abu Dhabi Campus in the UAE.



To Allan's credit too is a five-year Broadway career in several rock musicals including Hair and Jesus Christ Superstar along with his roles in such films as Nashville(1975), Slap Shot (1977), and Popeye (1980).



### **Marc Reid - CFO Lakeshore Entertainment**

Marc is the Chief Financial Officer of Lakeshore Entertainment Group LLC, a leading independent film production and distribution company. Mr. Reid is responsible for managing the financial operations of the Lakeshore group of companies and assessing the financial impact of its production, distribution and acquisition activities. Mr. Reid also runs Lakeshore's digital division, Off The Dock, which develops and produces cutting edge entertainment and distributes it on traditional and new media platforms. Prior to joining Lakeshore, Mr. Reid led GE Capital Market's debt syndications and private placement activities for GE Capital's media and telecommunications groups, where he was responsible for arranging and syndicating senior, second-lien and subordinated debt financings for corporate debt facilities and leveraged buyout transactions. Mr. Reid received a JD from New York University School of Law, and an MBA from NYU Stern School of Business where he received a teaching fellowship in macroeconomics. He holds a BA in International Relations – Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and a certificate in French Proficiency from the Sorbonne. Mr. Reid lives in Los Angeles with his wife, Kerry. They enjoy spending time with their daughter, Sydney and son, Harrison.

### Marc Rosen - Executive Producer of Sense8

Marc Rosen has over 20 years of experience as an Executive and Producer in Film and Television at both the major studio/network and independent producer level. With Season 2 of SENSE8 on Netflix, Marc has Executive Produced over 40 hours of highend (\$4-\$8mn/episode) scripted content from THRESHOLD with David Goyer (BATMAN BEGINS, MAN OF STEEL, CONSTANTINE), Brannon Braga (SALEM), and David Heyman (HARRY POTTER, GRAVITY), to SENSE8, one of Netflix's first original series, with the Wachowski's (THE MATRIX), to THE AFTER pilot with Chris Carter (XFILES) and Amazon.



Marc has been under exclusive production deals with Warner Brothers (TimeWarner), CBS (Viacom), Paramount (Viacom), and 20th Century Fox (Newscorp). He has been represented by Creative Artists Agency and William Morris Endeavor Agency. He graduated with Honors from Princeton with a B.A. in English Literature and a Minor in Theatre, and also served on the Staff of Senator Diane Feinstein.

Marc is also an EP/Creator of Series, including one that is about to be announced with Appian Way/Leonardo DiCaprio Exec Producing, and the adaptation of J.G. Ballard's SciFi classic THE DROUGHT for Michael DeLuca (Former President of Sony and New Line) (THE SOCIAL NETWORK, MONEYBALL).

From 2012-2015, Marc was the Co-Founder and C.E.O of Georgeville Television with Reliance Entertainment – the proprietors of Steven Spielberg's Dreamworks. During GVTV's run, Marc set up 10 Series, including LIMITLESS, THE AFTER (Chris Carter/Amazon), FROM DUSK TIL DAWN, ZORRO, and several others.

Prior to GVTV, he had Exclusive Producing Deals in Film and Television - with Paramount Film and CBS TV respectively – through his RosenObst PRODUCTIONS, with Lynda Obst (INTERSTELLAR, HOT IN CLEVELAND, SLEEPLESS IN SEATTLE, CONTACT, HOW TO LOSE A GUY IN 10 DAYS) from 2007-2009. During that time, Marc set up 20 T.V. series though the CBS Deal...

Leading up to those deals, from 2001-2007, Rosen was the first Senior Executive and Founder of the Warner Brothers offices of HEYDAY FILMS/David Heyman (HARRY POTTER Franchise, GRAVITY). During his tenure, he worked on films with Christopher Nolan (DARK KNIGHT, INCEPTION, INTERSTELLAR), Jonah Nolan (WESTWORLD), David Goyer, and founded the company's television division - Heyday Television, based at Warner Brothers - on the heels of his series THRESHOLD for CBS.

### **JUDGES**



### **Ernest Thompson - Writer, Producer, Director**

Ernest has won an Oscar, a Golden Globe, a Writers Guild Award and a Broadway Drama Guild Award for Best Play. His work has been nominated for a Tony, an Emmy and a British Academy Award. His more than 35 plays have been seen in theatres around the world. The most enduring, ON GOLDEN POND, has been translated into 30 languages, Arabic the newest, and played in more than 40 countries on six continents.

Other plays include THE WEST SIDE WALTZ (starring Katharine Hepburn and Dorothy Loudon), A SENSE OF HUMOR (Jack Lemmon and Estelle Parsons), AX OF LOVE, AMAZONS IN AUGUST, MURDERING MOTHER, WHITE PEOPLE CHRISTMAS, THE ELIXIR, and HUMAN BEINGS. His soon to be released anthology of 25 short plays contains the collections THE PENIS RESPONDS, ANSWERS and VALENTINES FOR TWO, as well as THE ONE ABOUT THE GUY IN THE BAR and AMERICAN TERRORIST.

His films include ON GOLDEN POND (Katharine Hepburn, Henry Fonda and Jane Fonda), SWEET HEARTS DANCE (Susan Sarandon and Jeff Daniels), THE LIES BOYS TELL (Kirk Douglas), 1969 (Robert Downey Jr. and Bruce Dern), THE WEST SIDE WALTZ (Shirley MacLaine and Liza Minnelli), OUT OF TIME (James McDaniel and Mel Harris), and the live ON GOLDEN POND (Julie Andrews and Christopher Plummer), the last four of which Ernest also directed, as he has his latest films, TIME AND CHARGES and HEAVENLY ANGLE. Both were produced with his partners in Whitebridge Farm Productions, Morgan Murphy and Lori Gigliotti Murphy, and offered as On Location Training to anyone of any background, experience or age interested in any aspect of filmmaking. Eager to return to his love of community filmmaking, Ernest is already planning to direct and act in Whitebridge Farm Productions' third film, an adaptation of his play HUMAN BEINGS, when his schedule permits.

In the theatre, Ernest had directed many of his plays, most recently ON GOLDEN POND in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire, close to where his iconic film was shot. For his first time directing the play on stage, Ernest collaborated with longtime composing partner Joe Deleault to create two new songs, THE FATHER DAUGHTER DANCE, written with and performed by Carly Simon, and the anthemic ON GOLDEN POND, composed with and featuring the extraordinary Cape Breton fiddler Natalie MacMaster. Never having acted in his own play, Ernest got to see it from the inside out by taking on—to wild success—the role of Charlie the mailman.

Ernest conducts his internationally-renowned workshops for writers, actors and directors at his farm in rural New Hampshire, and offers private coaching to actors and public speakers and one-on-one script analysis.

A prolific songwriter, Ernest has written scores of lyrics and worked with a myriad of extraordinary composers and singers and he has directed videos for his songs BRONTË BROOK, written with and performed by the remarkably talented Ray Porcell, and YOU ARE LOVED, written with and performed by the legendary Justin Jaymes. Ernest's music is available on iTunes and at Amazon and other online outlets.

Ernest is in discussions to direct a fourth Broadway run of ON GOLDEN POND as well as the London West End premiere. Ernest and his Broadway producers are out to some very exciting, hope-to-be-revealed-soon stars for his new play SOME PARTS MISSING, and his newest, ASK|ANSWER, is headed for a New York workshop. He will direct the long-awaited sequel to ON GOLDEN POND, slated to film this autumn, and is working on a remake of THE PAPER CHASE for Fox 2000, with several other films on the docket.





During the total solar eclipse of 2017 across the US, Carbondale IL was the site of the longest duration of totality. 



As a filmmaker, I brought Dick's wild and crazy shirts to the big screen knowing that this film won't change the world, but for the four and a half minutes it takes to watch, you won't care.




### Community Snapshot

### **THOSE 4 WALLS**



### UNWELCOME

### Synopsis

The 2017 short documentary film "Unwelcome" takes an unusual approach in covering the Syrian war by giving the microphone to a six year old refugee boy and letting him narrate the film himself.

In "Unwelcome" we meet six-year old Menwar, who lives in a tent at a gas station in Greece. He and his family fled the bloody conflict in Syria, hoping to start a new life. But when they finally reached Europe, they found a continent that did not want them; a continent that had closed its borders.

With heartwarming moments and humor, "Unwelcome" offers a unique invitation into the lives of these children who so violently have been forced to flee their homes. The film stands apart from other short documentaries in that so much happens in such a short time and that the film crew is there as it happens: onboard a Frontex police boat on a sharp mission, living in the refugee camp, running into a dark forest with six year old Menwar and other terrified refugees followed by police sirens and blue lights.

"Unwelcome" brings you straight into the action, fear, drama and chaos these children are forced to live through while on the run - all of it narrated by Menwar, and shown through the eyes of a child.

This is Menwar's story. This is the true story about the Syrian war. It's not the rebels, the bombs, ISIS or the army or the ghost cities. It's the victims of war. And who are more the victims than the children?

### **Community Snapshot**

"Unwelcome" follows a six year old boy who lives in a tent-community at a gas station in Greece after he fled Syria. In the improvised tent-camp at the closed gas station, the children have found a community of fellow refugees, while they are being shunned by the European community and not let in past the borders. For them, this is now home, this is all they have in the world - but the adults don't always understand that the rugged tents in the kids' eyes is their new neighborhood, their new community. The film climaxes as the police suddenly show up and start tearing down the tents in front of the children, before dramatically splitting up this new community and forcing the children and their families to make the hardest choice of their lives.



### **UP TO SNUFF**

### Synopsis

Shane and Chloe are frustrated writers because Hollywood isn't taking their calls, so they decide to make their own movie. I mean, how hard can it be? Virgin Cheerleaders in Chains will be a no budget slasher movie. Since the writers don't know anything about making a movie, they buy Movie Making for Morons and set to work. First they enlist their roomies: Chloe's stoner brother, Billy, and Nelson, yuppie business major. Then they cast their head cheerleader in a local strip club. Amber turns out to be a huge asset to the team - two assets, actually. Getting the money is a real problem. (Isn't it always?) They crowd fund, hold an investor party, and finally throw down their credit cards and from Billy a gallon freezer bag of weed. Their big break comes when horror icon Mike Beale (remember the '80s classics Maine Machete Massacre and Maine Maniac?) signs on for points on the back end. Mike also has the perfect location for Act III - an abandoned orphanage where only his Uncle Albert and Otto live with two Dobermans. Arriving at sunset, they shoot one scene in the basement before retiring for the night. But when Chloe and Amber discover a sub-basement and in it depravity beyond belief, their night becomes a nightmare. It will be the longest night of their lives, and for most, the last.
